Alderman Gately asked why the money is being taken from the Veteran's Cash Aid Account to pay for a student to go Essex North Shore School. President Haggerty stated that the money is to pay for an additional student that is attending the school, and that the money was extra money that the Veteran's agent would not need to complete this fiscal year. Alderman Concannon stated that the amount of money that the City pays for out of district students is constantly increasing, that the city should take a look at the current courses that are being offered at out of town schools and look into offering them in Woburn to keep students in the Woburn School system, and that the number of out of district student is increasing and is getting more expensive every year.
